

Reference for Guilhem Kuczynski

To whom it may concern,

A conventional curriculum vitae is a poor instrument for measuring the profile like that of Guilhem Kuczynski. It may record what he has done but it may not fully show what he is capable of. In my years across management consulting, artificial intelligence, university mentoring, and questions concerning the future of human society, I have met many able and ambitious people. Guilhem is among the few who have genuinely arrested my attention.

That is the reason why I have asked him to join on a part-time basis [Sustensis - AI Think Tank](#) on civilisational transition towards coexistence with Superintelligence. This is a demanding intellectual environment, embracing technology, ethics, governance, human wellbeing, organisational design and long-term societal change.
